YOUTH WORKFORCE INITIATIVE

Basic Program Eligibility

- between the ages of 16-29
- unemployed
- Canadian Citizen, Permanent Resident or person who has been granted refugee status in Canada
- have a social insurance number
- not *receiving* or *eligible* for E.I
- not currently enrolled in traditional schooling
- ability to remain engaged in a 16 week program
- available to work 25-35 hours per week

AND

In need of assistance in order to find and maintain employment.

Apply

Interviews

If selected, we will call/email you back to schedule an in person interview with an employment staff.

Applicant Selection

If eligible and selected for the program you will receive a call/email with program details.

Call backs of eligibility/acceptance no later than Thursday August 15, 2019

First 4 Weeks

Participants will attend mandatory employment preparation classes Monday-Friday from 8:30am-3:30pm at OCH.

Participants will be supported with completing various workshops, certifications, resume building, interview preparation and other employment related skills. Assistance with acquiring a job will also take place during this time.

August 19, 2019- September 13, 2019

Following 12 Weeks

The goal is to have employment secured by the 5th week of the program. If employment is secured you and your employer will be provided ongoing support from employment staff.

September 16, 2019 – December 6, 2019

End of program

After the 12 weeks of support the goal is that you can continue your job without the support of the program.

If you've kept your job after the program and your employer verifies this, you may be eligible for a program bonus.

Last day of program: December 6, 2019
