PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

On-line training

- Offers any Franco-Ontarian adult who needs training the chance to reach his or her learning goals, either fully online, or partly online and partly in the classroom in an adult education centre.
- The free courses being offered include: computers, reading, writing and communication, mathematics for business and everyday life, essential skills.
Admissibility criteria: French speaking, 19 years or older, residing in Ontario, and having access, whether at home or elsewhere, to a computer with an Internet connection.

Tourism and Human Resources

- Aims to create and offer specialized training in French to develop the skills and ensure the employability of Francophone people with low literacy and Francophone newcomers who want to enter the labor market in the field of tourism and hospitality in Ontario. The duration of this training program is 16 weeks (including three weeks of internship).
