Key Programs & Services for Employers

Employment Ontario Centre

Provides help in finding and hiring skilled employees. Free services include:

- job postings; screening and matching services; job fairs
- experienced employment specialists; local labour market information
- job retention services; apprenticeship information

Canada-Ontario Job Grant (COJG)

- Financial support for short-term training
- Available to small, medium and large employers across Ontario
- Can cover training for both existing and new employees

Youth Futures

- A 7-month program, which connects employers with youth to hire as summer students
- We provide (in both official languages) advanced leadership training, a variety of employment positions and a post-secondary experience

Hire a young person

- Hire a young person through Employment Service, Youth Job Connection or Youth Job Connection Summer
- Get \$1,000-\$2,000 through the Employing Young Talent Incentive, for hiring and retaining a young person (15 to 29 years old), if you are:
 - a small business (fewer than 100 employees), through Employment Service
 - an employer of any size, through Youth Job Connection
