Key Programs & Services for Employers

Employment Resource Centre (CERC)

Provides employment services to Ontario employers, assisting them to find suitable candidates and greatly reduce recruitment costs. Services include:

- Hosting job fairs and hiring fairs
- Access to training incentives for suitable new hires
- Employment training and preparation for candidates and new hires

Canada-Ontario Job Grant (COJG)

- Get direct financial support for short-term training
- Can cover training for both existing and new employees

Language Training (Fee required)

- A wide range of language training to satisfy your company's needs.
- Allow employees to prepare for the BBB, CBC or CAC testing

Tailored Skills training (Formation sur-mesure) (Fee required)

- Tailored and diverse training delivered in English and French
- Transfer of learning to the workplace immediately (tools)
- Case studies, teamwork, individual work for reflection, role play, discussion

Leadership Program (Fee required)

- A series of practical workshops adapted to the reality of today and of tomorrow
- The development of the essential skills needed to be recognized as a good leader
- 7 intensive one-day workshops over a period of two months

Advanced Coaching Program (Fee required)
