Key Programs & Services for Employers

Hiring an individual with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)

- Y's Owl Maclure supports approximately 300 people and offers a wide range of services from centre-based programs to community engagement

Onsite job coaching

- Training of an employee by an Employment coach who uses structured intervention techniques to help the employee learn to perform job tasks to the employer's specifications
- Coaches remain available to the employer and co-workers as an ongoing resource and to ensure a long term relationship
- All training and support services are provided at no cost to the employer

Accommodations & assistive technology

- Assist in making changes to a job or to the work environment to assist the employee with job tasks or make the job easier to complete
- Options include specialized computer software, mechanical devices; augmentative communication; materials in alternate format; change in work schedule; organizers and schedules

Training Courses

- *Managing Employees with Autism Training Course* will provide a greater understanding of autism and increase confidence in ability to manage employee with autism effectively
- *Understanding Co-workers with an ASD* will give a greater understanding of autism spectrum disorder (ASD) and increase confidence in working effectively with colleagues with an ASD

- Offers professional and creative spaces ideal for private meetings, workshops and presentations
- A social enterprise that specifically hires and trains individuals on the autism spectrum and other developmental disabilities
