Volunteer Tutors

- If you are interested in volunteering with People, Words & Change, please contact us. One of our counsellors will answer your questions and give you more information before you apply.
- Tutor Orientation, Match Support, and Tutor Workshops - If your application is accepted, you will be asked to attend a two-hour tutor orientation session which usually takes place in the evening. Once you have completed the orientation, we will place you on a list of active tutors who are waiting to be matched with a learner.
- The Educational Counsellors at PWC provide regular, ongoing support to each match through emails, phone calls and monthly tutor reports. PWC also offers tutor workshops several times a year where tutors can learn new skills and strategies for tutoring and share ideas with other tutors.
