Pharmaceutical review officers (PROs) are at the very centre of the work we produce at CADTH. PROs provide health care decision-makers with objective evidence to help make informed decisions about the optimal use of pharmaceutical products.

As a PRO, you will conduct evidence-based reviews of pharmaceutical products and prepare reports on your findings. You will have the ability to work on a wide variety of reviews in a collaborative, team-based environment, supported by specialists in areas such as research methodology, health economics, project management, information science, and health policy. You will have opportunities for continuous learning and development (such as in the areas of research and project coordination).

On any given day you will:

- conduct comprehensive literature reviews, critical appraisals, evidence syntheses, and other relevant research activities, including indirect comparisons, meta-analyses, and systematic reviews
- prepare reports that effectively communicate research findings in a format that meets customers' needs (e.g., technical reports, briefing papers, and manuscripts)
- present research findings and methodologies to colleagues, customers, and expert and jurisdictional advisory committees
- collaborate with external content experts, reviewers, stakeholders, and others to ensure the successful execution of assigned projects.

Is this the right role for you?

As a PRO, you will have:

- a master's degree (or higher) in a health-related discipline

- excellent communication and scientific writing skills
- an understanding of the principles of evidence-based medicine and study design
- experience in conducting critical appraisals, systematic reviews, meta-analyses, and health technology assessments
- a good understanding of the Canadian health care system, and knowledge of the decision-making processes for drugs and other health technologies at the federal, provincial, and territorial levels, including the role of CADTH
- knowledge of conducting and appraising indirect treatment comparisons
- knowledge of general statistical and meta-analysis software; for example, Review Manager and SAS

Fluency in French will be considered an asset.
